

What is homeschooling?

- ❖ Homeschooling is an educational alternative in which parents and students take control of the learning process.
- ❖ Parents exercise their constitutional right to educate their children. In most cases, this process unfolds as a collaborative effort between parent and student, as it is tailored to each student's interests, strengths, and weaknesses.
- ❖ It is considered an educational alternative, not a competitor to the traditional education system.
 - ✓ There are children suited to—and who thrive in—every type of setting: public schools, private schools, and homeschooling.
 - ✓ The traditional system (whether public or private) loses revenue when children are withdrawn from school.



The right to be educated belongs to the child.
