

Difference between learning and teaching

Learning

- ❖ Can be done independently (autonomy)
- ❖ Takes place within the individual
- ❖ Is neither moral nor immoral
- ❖ Acquisition of something
- ❖ Active involvement
- ❖ Freedom and space to make decisions
- ❖ Collaboration is fostered
- ❖ Competencies regarding processes, as well as the search for, selection of, and handling of information lifelong

Teaching

- ❖ It takes place involving two or more people (limited autonomy)
- ❖ It is not something that occurs internally
- ❖ It can be imparted in a moral or immoral manner
- ❖ Involves the transmission of something
- ❖ Passive and reactive involvement
- ❖ Expectation of being told what to do (limited scope for decision-making)
- ❖ Individuality is encouraged
- ❖ Skills involving memory and the replication of content
- ❖ Restricted to specific periods of life
