

Social Security

- ❖ In general, children of pensioned, deceased or disabled beneficiaries who are full-time students are entitled to benefits until they reach the age of 18 or complete their secondary education (grade 12 or below), whichever occurs first.
- ❖ The situation occurs when they turn 18 and have not yet completed high school, and it is difficult for them to prove that they are full-time students.
- ❖ The process can be difficult and time consuming since in PR the HS is not regulated nor there is a public policy or official definition on the part of the government, which may represent an obstacle, due to regional policies or local guidelines that may be discriminatory for homeschoolers.
